Guideline for recruiting and selecting young volunteers for:

„Fun&Skills”

An innovative project initiated by the ISF Youth Council

Selection criteria:

Age: Between 14-30 years old.

Language skills: The young volunteers shall SPEAK ENGLISH. We do not expect bilingual kids, but a relatively high level of English is expected so that the young volunteers can engage in all activities with their peers without strong language barriers.

Background (level of involvement): The young volunteer shall have experience in school sport and/or volunteering activities. Advantages:

- experience in organization of events, activities at their school sport organization and/or local community;
- experience in ISF events (as a volunteer, member of LOC etc.)
- who will be involved as a volunteer in 2018/2019/2020 events

Participation: We expect all participants to be highly motivated and to participate in FIRST PHASE of the project (2018-2019)

1) YOUNG VOLUNTEERS' TRAINING: dates to be determined (3 days, April 2018)

2) ISF World Championships as organiser of “FUN&SKILLS” ZONES (2018-2019)

- o places: will be fixed later according to discussions with ISF and LOCs in each year
- o plan: 3-6 volunteers will be involved per event together with 1-2 Youth Council member will attend and help their work as well.
- o Preparation: sharing ideas and experiences throughout the whole project (emails, skype), and contribution to the final handbook (collection of suggestions).
- o Local implementations: young volunteers invited to share, use their studies at local events and send a feedback to ISF Youth Council on their experiences.

**Selection:**

ISF Youth Council will check the applications and select participants (5-15) in the view of the above-mentioned criteria. ISF Youth Council reserves the right to organize personal/skype discussions with applicants before final decision. ISF will inform the chosen volunteers and their organization to start to make common further steps.

Cost coverage:

All costs (including travel, insurance, accommodation in full board) related to the phases 1-2 described above will be covered by the ISF for the chosen Young Volunteers.

Caretaker:

Trainers will have the necessary competences in youth work, non-formal education and in sport activities with young people. 1 or 2 members of the Youth Council will be present in each activity. However, the project **does not include the presence of an adult person** accompanying the young volunteers.

Arrangements shall be planned by ISF to assure a safe arrival and departure of the young volunteers at all phases. However, if you require an adult person to go through the whole project with your volunteers, you are free to propose one and we will be glad to arrange his or her stays. All costs related to his/her participation will not be covered by ISF.

- School consent: written by the school headmaster accepting the eventual absences of the young volunteers due to their participation in the project
- Parents consent (if the volunteer is under 18)
